Plant Commentary December 2009 Meeting:

Flower of Division – First Division: *Lc.* Chit Chat 'Tangerine' benched by Eileen Pinock.


This was a mature well-grown plant with many canes, seven of which carried inflorescences of from three to nine fully open flowers. Flowers were about 50mm wide and 60mm tall, there sepals and petals were bright orange as was the labellum which became a little paler towards the base. *C. aurantiaca*, which can have flowers from yellow to bright orange, is one of the parents of this plant.



Flower of Division – Open Division and Flower of the Night: *Phrag.* Geralda benched by Geraldine and Peter Flavel.

This was a robust plant of three growths and a single inflorescence, a progressive flowerer with two open flowers and a further two buds still to open. One flower was 50mm wide and some 180mm tall while the other was 75mm wide at the bottom of the petals and 150mm from the top to the ends of the petals. The dorsal and ventral sepals were cream with light striping and some pink shading. The petals were pale pink with darker pink edges and darkening towards the tips and the pinkish pouch was overlaid with green and was spotted in red inside.
