## **November Plant Commentary**

This month we had two examples of *Cym.* Cricket 'Rosetta' which were benched by Rito and Rosetta Silvestri (**Flower of First Division**) and George Misirlis (**Flower of Second Division**). Both were very well grown, displaying inflorescences cascading down around the pots.

**The Flower of First Division and Flower of the Night:** This was a little larger in plant size than the Flower of second division and carried about 40 cascading spikes which were just a bit longer and with a few more flowers per spike than the second division plant. The quality of the flowers was very good for both plants and the larger of the two plants was chosen as the Flower of the Night due to the longer inflorescences and higher number of flowers per spike.

Both plants had flowers which were 30mm. tall and 25mm. wide. Sepals and petals were pale green overlaid with brown. The labellum was very deep maroon with a pale green column and a cream coloured pollen cap.

Congratulations to Rito and Rosetta for winning **Best in First Division** and **Flower of the Night**. Congratulations to George for winning **Best in Second Division**.

**The Flower of Open Division**: was *Rlc.* Sylvia Fry 'Olga' benched by Richard and Beryl Wilson. It was a well grown plant with three inflorescences each carrying two flowers which were 150mm. tall and 140mm. wide. The sepals and petals were pristine white and the petals were nicely frilled (or ruffled) around the edges. The white labellum was ruffled right around the edge and towards the


