Plant Commentary, August 2009 Meeting.

Flower of Open Division and Flower of the Night:

Dock. teretifolia grown by Peter and Geraldine Flavel. A well grown example of this Australian native species, the plant was of medium size with many Inflorescences, mainly carrying 6 flowers. Sepals and petals cream-white and fine red spotting around the frilled edge of the white reflexed labellum





Flower of First Division:

Den. (Steven x *teretifolium*) 'Black Pam' grown by Heather Engelhardt. A large well grown plant with a good number of inflorescences generally carrying around five flowers each. Flowers were 30mm across and 25 mm tall. Sepals and petals were cream with maroon stripes and the cream labellums were finely spotted maroon. The *Den.* Steven parent has the New Guinea species Den. fulginosum, so it is judged as an 'any other Dendrobium hybrid' even though there is Australian species in its background.



Flower of Second Division:

Cym. Baltic Glacier 'Mint Ice' grown by Vicky Cooper. A well grown plant with a single inflorescence. A very attractive display.

Champion of First Division:

Dock. teretifolia grown by David and Kay Cammack. A floriferous medium to large sized plant of this Australian native species, flowers well displayed and cascading down from the base of the plant. Sepals and petals white with pale cream on the reverse at their bases. The white labellum was lightly dusted along the edge with fine red spotting.



Champion of Second Division:

Cym. Valley Olympic 'Pink Perfection' grown by Joy Grund. A well grown plant of this clone with the inflorescences displayed out of the foliage. The pink flowers had good filled in shape with rounded sepals and petals, these segments being complemented by the white labellum spotted and shaded around the edge. The column was pink with a white pollen cap.
